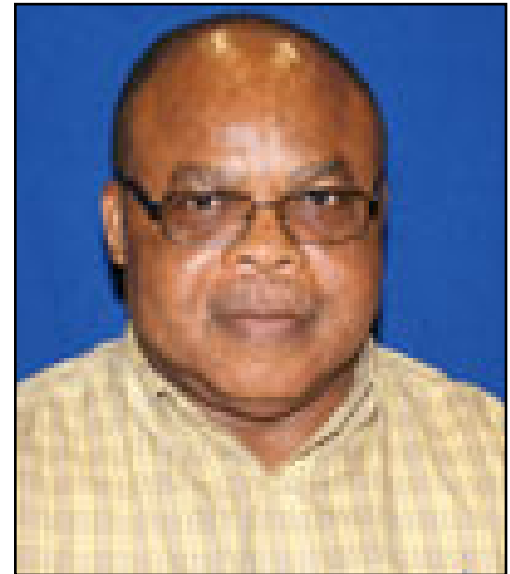

## Dr. Okereke's SuperLecture to focus on economic opportunities debate

Dr. Godpower Okereke, Professor of Sociology and Criminal Justice at Texas A&M University-Texarkana, will present a SuperLecture titled "The Economic Opportunities Debate: What Makes Sense and What Doesn't" on Thursday, March 3, at 9 a.m. in University Center 210 on the A&M-Texarkana campus, 7101 University Ave., Texarkana, Texas.

"The presentation will focus on income and wealth inequality in America and comparable countries," said Dr. Okereke, who earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Sociology from Oklahoma State University and master's and bachelor's degrees in Criminal Justice from the University of Central Oklahoma.

Dr. Okereke's research interests include globalization, the global economy, economic development, political economy, violence against women, governance, global poverty and inequality, crime and punishment, incarceration and crimes against humanity. His works have been published in numerous professional publications.

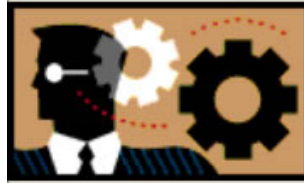
